World History Grades: 7-8

Course Description

Improve note-taking skills.

World History is a course designed for students to study civilizations of the world through the lens of a Christian worldview. This course will begin with a brief review of history from Creation to the coming of Christ and progresses in a chronological journey around the world studying various empires, cultures, Christianity, and world religions. This course concludes with an examination of the trends of the emerging 21st century. Goals of this course include:

Encourage Christian growth
Promote historic and geographic literacy.
Organize knowledge in a spiral pattern and/or chronologically.

Evaluate events and people in history from a Christian point of view Present historic events that emphasize skill-building exercises Promote an understanding of and an ability to discern connections among events.

Strengthen a knowledge of God working though history and our lives.

Write complete/concise essays and speeches and present them to the class.
